- 5. Enhancement ofself-image
- 6. Needs vs. Wants
- 7. Development of higher stages of planning and reasoning

Domestic Violence

The program confronts batter's beliefs and behaviors especially focusing on power and control issues. The program meets all of the criteria established by the Governor's Task Force on Domestic Violence.

The program is 26 weekly sessions which includes DV assessments and intakes.

Groups are separated by gender and are open-ended.

"Paths to Change" Responsible Behavior

The program focuses on self evaluation, personal responsibility, needs and wants, thinking errors, problem solving and goal setting. The program is designed for first offense Shoplifting/Theft offenses; License Violations; Under Age Poss.; etc. The program is 4 (2) hours weekly

group sessions in a small group (10-12) setting.
